Historical Statues



You can learn a lot by looking at

historical statues. Take, for example, a statue of a soldier on a horse. Some things you can see right away. You can tell how large or small the man was. You can see what kind of uniforms soldiers once wore and what guns they carried. But you can also learn

some things that are not so obvious. There are certain things you can look for. For instance, the horse can tell you how the soldier died. If it has all four hooves on the ground, the man died a natural death. If one hoof is in the air, it means he died of wounds received while fighting. If two hooves are raised, then the rider was killed right on the field of battle.
